WHO WE ARE

Lugo de Llanera Primary School opened in 1975 with the aim of providing early years foundation stage and primary education to all the children from the small town of Lugo de Llanera as well as the villages around.

It is a state-funded educational institution depending entirely from the Education and Culture Administration of the Government of the Principality of Asturias.

It is a fairly large co-educational school with around 500 students supported by 44 staff.

We've got a vibrant and strong learning community where children thrive.

We encourage our students to fully develop all their personal skills, organizing and planning projects, activities, environment and materials to achieve it.



ACADEMIC INFO

Educational stages

We offer early years foundation stage (ages 3-5) and primary education (ages 6-11).

Term dates and calendar

The academic calendar begins on the first days of September and finishes on the last days of June. The academic activity is divided into three terms:

First term: from September to December (Christmas) Second term: from January to March (Easter) Third term: from April to June (Summer)

There are three holiday periods: Christmas, Easter and Summer. Summer holidays begin on the last days of June and end on the first days of September.



WHAT WE LOOK FOR

The policy of our school is to improve the relationships of the educative community, our environment and an open communication based on respect for diversity.

We have ongoing projects to help all our pupils to feel integrated in the society and offset the social differences.

The aim to improve our physical and social environment converges in the programmes we develop.

We try to apply inclusive teaching taking into account the multiple learning styles of our students with the project: Jóvenes con ideas (kids with ideas), besides an inclusive structure of support to students with difficulties.

One of the oldest projects is related to the promotion of reading skills, using the library as the thrust to fulfill it.

Since 2009 we apply CLIL teaching, using, nowadays, English language to teach Natural Science. Extending the use of a second language provides a wider range of opportunities to our students to know other realities.

ICT project is especially addressed to develop computer competences in this field of knowledge; we have started a close collaboration with the University of Oviedo to apply Augmented Reality to Science, both Social and Natural. We incorporate these competences to the learning of curricular subjects.

Knowing other cultures helps us, pupils, families and teachers, to respect diversity.



WHY ERASMUS+

Our main strategic goals are to internationalize our school and to learn from new school systems which let us widen and improve our teaching and learning approach.

As part of our internationalization project we provide opportunities to participate and implement European cooperation projects, as well as to host professionals willing to do job-shadowing of our educative system.

We are open to international and cross-cultural projects.

We are open to new ideas and inspired visions from our colleagues in Europe.

For that reason we are initiating a KA1 mobility Project framed on Erasmus+.



OUR BACKGROUND

We started participating in European Programs in 2008. Since then we have been an active part in two interesting Comenius Projects during four years.

We have also hosted different Language assistants from Bulgaria, Poland, Germany and Ireland, who have been a key part in our school life, and who have facilitated an intercultural learning process.

Besides this, we have occasionally hosted other American professionals who have made significant contributions to our daily routines.



WHERE WE ARE

Our school is located in a small town close to Oviedo, the capital of our region, Asturias, in the North of Spain. It belongs to the Llanera Council, in the central area of Asturias.



HOW TO GET HERE

By plane

The Airport of Asturias (Aeropuerto de Asturias – OVD) is located in Santiago del Monte, 48 km far from Oviedo. Oviedo is easily reached from the airport by taxi and by bus in about 30 minutes. Then you can get to our school by train. More information: www.aena.es
